

WHAT IS SUSPICIOUS?

The police department cannot function effectively without the assistance of concerned, responsible citizens. We are depending on you to call and report suspicious people and activity. **Do not worry about "bothering" the police**.

THINGS TO WATCH OUT FOR AND CALL 911:

- Vehicles that are being loaded with valuables if parked in front of a closed business, or an unattended residence.
- A vehicle that does not belong to you or your neighbors abandoned on your street or with people sitting inside.
- Anyone removing accessories or license plates from a car.
- A person loitering and looking in vehicles in a parking lot.
- A stranger or juveniles knocking on doors in your neighborhood or going in backyards of residences.
- An unknown subject standing in front of a residence talking on a cell phone.
- Subjects loitering in parks or taking pictures of children.
- Any unknown person looking in/or around mailboxes.
- Anything that looks suspicious and not normal for your neighborhood.

While some, if not all, of the situations described above could have innocent explanations, we would rather investigate the situation than be called when it is too late.
